As one of the most common surgeries performed in the US, cataract surgery is a prime target for scrutiny by public and private payers alike. A recent multi-state audit by a Medicare Administrative Contractor yielded a 51% error rate for cataract surgery documentation. That data is being eyed by Medicare and commercial carriers alike and could serve as the basis for future cataract surgery prior authorization requirements.

In response, the NYS Ophthalmological Society is offering a 60-minute webinar to help ophthalmologists and their staffs adopt audit-proof strategies and documentation protocols in their practice.
